Book Buying Program

Here, at A Freethinker's Corner, we carry a wide variety of new and used books, and love to keep our shelves stocked with new titles. We're always looking to acquiring additional fiction and nonfiction titles, hardcover and paperback, and we thank you for your interest in keeping the books we have to offer varied and fresh. Please read our book buying policy below before contacting us or stopping by.

This is how our program works...

- We only accept books during our book buying hours (Wed-Fri from 10am-4pm). We will go through them while you wait. This may take a bit, depending upon having to do any searches. Please plan accordingly.
- On a walk-in basis, we will only accept up to 15 books at one time. If you wish to bring more than 15, or any rare/antiquarian/collectible books, please call or email the store to make an appointment to drop them off. Depending on the number of books or research involved, they may need to stay with us for a few days. Keep in mind, we are not appraisers, and will do our best to offer you a fair value. We will go through them as quick as possible and contact you when we're finished.
- Whether as a walk-in or drop-off, we may not accept all of the books you bring us. Our staff reserves the right to pass on any book(s) they deem unusable. Any unpurchased books must be removed by the owner.
- Generally, A Freethinker's Corner will pay between 12% and 15% cash (check if over \$50), or 18% and 20% as in-store credit (to be used on the purchase of books only). The specific price is based on the book's original retail price, and depends on (but is not limited to) the book, author, subject, and condition.

What we do not accept (to include but not be limited to)...

- Moderate to Heavily highlighted/underlined/handwritten notes
- Strong smelling/Moldy/Dirty/Water damaged (this includes dust jacket condition)
- Moderate to Heavily Torn/Creased (this includes dust jacket condition)
- Magazines
- Non-print media
- Donations
